Organization Name	Amount Requested	Purpose
City of Redding Police Dept.	\$10,000	35 sets of protective fire gear police department
City of Redding Recreation Division	\$5,000	Purchase native trees, shrubs, and irrigation systems to restore riparian areas along Sacramento River Trail
Exodus Farms Ministry	\$9,100	To provide funding to assist with Carr Fire survivors horse riding program, hay and maintenance of evacuated horses & purchase of tractor
Haven Humane Society	\$10,000	Offset costs for Shasta Gateway Outlet building cleaning, fuel costs, operating supplies, food, and medical care for burned animals
KIXE-TV	\$2,500	Assist in covering insurance deductible that resulted due to tower damages from Carr Fire
Lewiston Sparkies	\$10,000	Provide heating and air units to the engine bay of the new Lewiston Fire Station
Redding Cooperative Preschool	\$2,535	To provide tuition to enrolled students of families impacted by Carr Fire, clean HVAC system, and upgrade exterior door seals
Shasta District Fairgrounds	\$10,000	Revitalize Shasta District Fair & Event Center buildings after hosting fire crews all summer
Shasta Elementary PTA	\$5,000	Rebuild PTA shed and replace its contents/supplies including tables, chairs, coolers, shelving units, storage bins, etc.
Shasta Family YMCA	\$5,000	Free YMCA memberships for Carr Fire survivors
ShiningCare, Inc	\$5,000	Support the Older Adult Gatekeeper Program with volunteer background checks, training materials, assessment materials, disaster/emergency preparedness kits, mileage, seminar expenses, etc.
The Salvation Army	\$10,000	Rental or mortgage assistance for Carr Fire survivors
Turtle Bay Exploration Park	\$10,000	Add to lost revenue due to the fires by bringing "Roots of Wisdom" exhibition
